

### **Application for Fellowship**

Thank you for expressing your interest in becoming a PAIRS Fellow! We appreciate your eagerness to become part of our community of distinguished physicians and scientists in the field of interventional radiology and imaging techniques.

The following guidelines constitute the minimum criteria to support your application. However, it is important to note that the Fellowship Committee will give the utmost priority to the quality and scope of your contribution to the field of Interventional Radiology during the application review process for FPAIRS.

Our PAIRS fellowship is designed to acknowledge and reward those who have dedicated themselves to advancing the field of interventional radiology and imaging techniques. As such, we are excited to review your application and learn more about your contributions to the field.

### **Requirements for Fellowship:**

The requirements for PAIRS Fellowship are as follows:

- You have been an active member in good standing of the Society for at least two years.
  Definition of "active member": A member who participated in one or more of the activities of the Society for example participation in the Scientific Meeting; organizing and conducting workshops; participating in societal committees and taking part in editorial activities related to AJIR.
- > You have made a significant contribution to interventional radiology by fulfilling at least one of the following criteria:
  - You have been the first author of at least eight significant papers on interventional subjects in refereed journals. **OR**,
  - You have been involved in the full-time supervision and training of residents and/or fellows in interventional radiology for a minimum of eight years. **OR**,
  - You have been an exceptional leader or teacher through his/her service to interventional radiology.
- Individuals practicing outside of the Arab World shall have the option of applying as Active or Corresponding Fellows.
- ➤ Letters of support from two Fellows in good standing in the Society.
- Deadline for application submission is Oct 31 each year.

The applications will be assessed by the Fellowship Affairs Committee for preliminary approval. The committee may seek confirmatory information from fellows of PAIRS or other sources as it may see fit. A list of successful candidates who meet the criteria and are approved by the committee shall be presented to the Board for information and comments at least six weeks before the Annual Meeting and the candidates will be granted the Fellowship status and inaugurated during the following Annual meeting. If you feel that you meet the above-mentioned criteria and are interested in applying for PAIRS Fellowship, please complete the following application form and return it to the PAIRS office (info@pairs-society.org) with the required documentation.
